**M**y name is Faith. Tommy and I were only three weeks away from getting married when he died of a heart attack. I was devastated. What I miss most is our Bible studies. We spent many hours studying God's Word. I ended up with no money and no job. I kept moving from shelter to shelter, trying to figure out what to do with my life. All I wanted was a friend, but no one was really there to help. Many of the shelters I stayed in were a far cry from what I'm enjoying here at MorningStar Mission. Some shelters just had thin prison mats on the floor. People were crawling all over each other because the quarters were so tight. But here at MorningStar I have my own place, the baby has a crib and my other children have nice beds. I never thought I would need a shelter, but here I am at the Mission's Women and Children Recovery Center. And this is exactly what it is: *a place to recover, regroup and to start over.*

## **I will remember your thoughtfulness for the rest of my life**

I also want to say a kind word to you who give so much of your money and service to help people like me. I cannot even begin to describe the beauty of this shelter. I want you to know from the depths of my heart how much I appreciate the good food you give us, along with the safe shelter and such nice clothes. Wherever I am for the rest of my life, I will always remember your acts of Christian kindness.
