Well, my early complaint has now turned into accepting my responsibility as a *blessing*. I've already raised Montrez' sister, and now I can say I have the *privilege* of raising Montrez. His dad is incarcerated and his mother is unable to care for him. Therefore, he is my responsibility.

Another reason I feel blessed is here at the Mission, Montrez is able to enjoy a positive experience with other children. Because we are homeless, we both appreciate the food, clothing and safe shelter. It was tough for me to lose my jobs and my apartment. There were times when I wondered where life was leading me. Now I can say God has been on my side all the time, and I'm so grateful. He has led us to MorningStar Mission.

This is an amazing place. We have our own room, our own bathroom, and all the necessities of life. It's also a spiritual place, where both my grandson and I are learning

to lean on God for everything. It's exciting to see Montrez learn how to pray out loud. So I guess the lesson for me is when it seems like all doors close, *another door opens*. That seems to be the way God works. I also want to *thank you*, who give so much of your time, energy and money to make this place available to people like us. I will always remember how you are reaching out to us.

Instead, it drove me further into a deep, dark hole.

I can now sit down and do something other than use drugs

The good news is I no longer live in that hole, because I have since committed my life to Jesus Christ. I now have a passion for God and his Word. Because of my relationship with my heavenly Father, I also want to be a role model for my younger brother — especially since I was the one who gave him his first high.

I never thought I could quit using drugs . . . but God is giving me the power to overcome my addiction

If you don't believe in a miracle, then I hope you would look at my life — because *I am the definition of a miracle*. God has completely turned my life around. For the first time, I can actually sit down and do something other than

use drugs. I owe this new lifestyle to a loving God, a caring staff at MorningStar Mission and to you who donate so much to keep the doors open for someone like me.

I never thought I would be clean again. But here I am — clean, sober and doing my best to live for Jesus Christ. No longer am I on the streets selling drugs. Instead, I am beginning to make something of my life for the first time. I'm so grateful for all you keep doing to help someone like me find my way home to God.
