Brett and his son recently came back to MorningStar to help start a new life together. "It's the change we needed so I could save for a house and stay on track. Life has challenges and this brings us some stability while I work and save."

Brett also likes that he's able to give back by helping at MorningStar, whether it's loading trucks to give food out or helping in the kitchen.
