THE POSITION

The Controller is a member of the senior leadership team and is responsible for overseeing financial operations for payroll, accounting processes, payment of expenses, budgeting and overall financial management, including property management, Gifts-in-Kind procedure and reporting. Additionally, this person is responsible for all expense allocation, revenue and expenditures for the audit, and limited human resource functions.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

The next Controller for the MorningStar Mission will be a highly flexible professional who loves God, loves people, and loves accounting (in that order). You report to the Executive Director and work hand in hand with a senior leadership team that is committed to living out the vision of MorningStar.

If this is you, your willingness to "do what needs to be done" supersedes the formal description of your job. You see yourself as part of the team and embrace the opportunity to be a servant leader. Business formal, country club lunches, and a strict 8 to 5 are not the norm for this leadership and that's just fine with you.
